# 2.1 TENTATIVE TRACT MAP 0030-11; MAJOR SITE PLAN REVIEW 0648-11 AND DESIGN REVIEW COMMITTEE 4602-11 – NATIONAL OIL WELL VARCO

A proposal for the renovation of an existing industrial site, removal of multiple storage buildings, and construction of two industrial buildings resulting in 27,500 additional square feet.
