SUBJECT

COMMISSION BUSINESS: General Plan conformance finding for FY 2012-2013 through 2018-2019 seven-year Capital Improvement Program.

SUMMARY

The Capital Improvement Program (CIP) serves as a single comprehensive plan of proposed capital improvement projects for the budget year FY 2012-2013 and the six years thereafter. In accordance with state law, the City must determine that the CIP is consistent with the General Plan.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Find the projects identified within the proposed seven-year Capital Improvement Program are consistent with the City's General Plan.

AUTHORIZATION/GUIDELINES

California Government Code Section 65401 requires the City to prepare a coordinated program (i.e., Capital Improvement Program) identifying projects recommended for planning, initiation or construction during the ensuing fiscal year. In accordance with state law, the Planning Commission must review and report on the conformity of the CIP with the adopted General Plan.

PUBLIC NOTICE

The CIP General Plan conformity determination does not require public notice.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

Staff has reviewed the list of projects identified in the CIP and determined that a number of projects will involve the need for preparation of environmental documentation in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Those documents will be prepared during project refinement and finalized prior to the awarding of contracts by the City Council.

This CIP General Plan conformity determination report is not a project under CEQA.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Capital Improvement Program (CIP) serves as a single comprehensive plan of proposed capital improvement projects for the budget year FY 2012-2013 and the six years thereafter. The CIP is a budgeting and strategic planning tool used to determine the extent of future needs and sources of funding. The CIP identifies 26 newly added projects (Attachment 1) to the previous CIP, for a total of 118 projects (Attachment 2) being proposed for the seven-year period. The new projects encompass a range of City projects including: vapor extraction equipment replacement at Yorba Park; anti-graffiti coating for park facilities; paramedic emergency medical equipment replacement; construction of a new Fire Station 2; fire station unisex restroom facilities; replacement of the Council Chambers audio visual system; storm drain pollution prevention improvements; intersection improvements; road resurfacing/reconstruction; sidewalk, curb and gutter replacement; and, traffic signal synchronization.

ANALYSIS/STATEMENT OF THE ISSUES

Staff has reviewed the new projects identified within the proposed seven-year CIP for conformance with the City's General Plan. The projects identified in the CIP are consistent with City of Orange General Plan policy, and further the implementation of the General Plan. A matrix presenting project conformance with the General Plan and the anticipated environmental review is provided as Attachment 3 to this report.

ADVISORY BOARD RECOMMENDATION

The CIP itself does not go before either the Staff Review Committee or Design Review Committee during its development. Individual projects may go before one or both bodies, as appropriate, at the time the project moves forward toward implementation.
