



# Welcome to the Santiago Creek Trail

*Trail hours are from dawn to dusk*

*(OMC 12.48.130 and 12.48.090)*

Use of the City trails is a shared privilege, and your continued enjoyment requires compliance with the following safety guidelines and ordinances:

1. **Prohibited uses on the trail:** motorcycles, electric vehicles, golf carts, motorized vehicles, all-terrain vehicles, off-leash animals, horses, horse-drawn carriages or wagons, and dangerous animals. (OMC 12.48.070, OMC 12.48.055)
2. The Santiago Creek is a protected waterway. Neither trail users nor their animals are permitted to leave the trail to wade, swim or ride through the Creek.
3. Place all trash in the proper trash receptacles. (OMC 12.48.065)
4. No alcohol, weapons, fires, graffiti, or fireworks, are allowed. (OMC 12.48.030, OMC 12.48.050, OMC 8.37.030, OMC 12.48.085)
5. Animals must be on a leash no longer than 6 ft. and all pet waste must be disposed of in a proper trash receptacle. (OMC 12.48.56)
