








Looking east across the project site from the western edge of the property. The sportsfield lights from Grijalva Park, as well as two-story residences can be seen to the east of the project site.


Hillside development and ridgelines can be seen in the distance.




Looking southwest from the western edge of the project site. Santiago Creek and two story residences can be seen to the west of the project site.
