White Oak Ridge Landscape Improvements Newport Blvd. and Trails End Ln

PROJECT INFORMATION

The White Oak Ridge Landscape Improvements project is scheduled to begin in early August and continue through October. The renovation aims to reduce the turf area, improve irrigation, and replace trees and shrubs as necessary between Newport Blvd. and Trails End Ln.

The work will be performed by Marina Landscape, Inc., **714-949-6600** under the supervision of the City of Orange Public Works Department.

Construction Hours: 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday

Project Duration: Approximately **Sixty (60)** calendar days

The schedule may shift due to inclement weather or material supply issues. Residents are encouraged to monitor their sprinkler systems and turn them off if work is being done in front of their residence.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

The construction at White Oak Ridge from Newport Blvd. and Trails End Ln. will impact residents during construction hours, and street parking will be restricted within the construction areas. Residents should expect traffic delays and limited access to their homes during certain periods of construction activities.

The contractor will post “No Parking” signs at least 48 hours before construction activity in front of the affected properties. These signs will include updated schedule information, such as the type of work to be performed and the duration of the work to be completed. For the latest project information, please read and adhere to the no-parking signs along the curb.

SITE SAFETY

The City of Orange is taking extra steps to minimize potential impacts to residents in the project area and safety is of primary concern. Please keep away from the construction equipment and the construction area. During off-construction hours, parents are asked to keep children away from any parked and unattended equipment and any materials stored on the site.
