You are invited to attend the public hearing. You may return your ballot in the following ways:

- 1) Mail your assessment ballot to the address shown on the enclosed return envelope, so that it is received on or before June 9, 2015.
- 2) Deliver it in person to the City Clerk located at 300 East Chapman Avenue, Orange, CA, 92866.
- 3) Deliver it in person at the June 9, 2015 public hearing (starting at 6:00 p.m. at the City Hall located at 300 East Chapman Avenue, Orange, CA, 92866). FOLD SO THAT THIS SIDE IS ON THE INSIDE OF THE FOLD BEFORE PLACING THIS BALLOT IN THE RETURN ENVELOPE







Who May Complete this Official Assessment Ballot

- 1. If the property is owned by an individual, the individual may sign.
- 2. If a property is held by more than one person, any one may sign for all.
- 3. If two or more persons own the property as tenants-in-common or as joint 2. Fill in or clearly mark the oval next to the word "YES" or "NO" to approve or tenants, any one tenant-in-common, or joint tenant, may sign for all.
- 4. If the property is owned by a corporation, the assessment ballot may be signed for the corporation by an officer or officers authorized to make contracts or by resolution of the corporation's Board of Directors.
- 5. If the property is owned by another legal entity, the assessment ballot may be signed by any person authorized by law to make contracts for the entity.
- 6. If the property is owned by a public agency, the assessment ballot may be signed by any person authorized by law to make contracts for the agency or by resolution of the agency's Governing Board.



Steps for Completing the Official Assessment Ballot

- 1, Verify that the owner name, address, and parcel number(s) listed on the assessment ballot are correct. If they are not correct call (714) 744-5500.
- disapprove of the proposed assetsment. You may use a pencil or pen.
- 3. Sign and date the assessment ballot. Only official assessment ballots which are signed and marked with the property owner's support or opposition will be counted. After marking your vote, simply FOLD the assessment ballot so that your vote in on the inside of the fold. Then place the assessment ballot in the return envisione provided. No postage is necessary to mail back your assessment ballot.
